

## AAC Dishforth Attack Helicopter Facility, Thirsk, North Yorkshire



Haden Young, acting as a supply chain partner with AMEC Construction, have undertaken the £10m phased upgrading of 3 aircraft hangars and ancillary buildings for the new Attack Helicopter Facility to be based at AAC Dishforth.

Haden Young were responsible for the installation of the Mechanical and Electrical services, including Fire Protection.

The mechanical services included to the hangars a radiant heating system together with heating and ventilation to ancillary buildings. Fire protection was provided to all areas, and in the main hangars is activated by infra-red/ultra-violet detection, to NFPA and LPC standards.

In accordance with the 'Building Down Barriers' Initiative, the design and construct teams have used the principles of Supply Chain Management to develop the client's requirements to a completed installation. Haden Young continued the Supply Chain Management principles with the key members of the services team such as Fire Protection, Compressed Air, BEMS and Security specialists.
