

Royal Bolton Hospital, Bolton



This new Nucleus system hospital was built as an extension to the existing Bolton General Hospital.

After opening the hospital was renamed the Royal Bolton Hospital, and it provides new operating theatres; audiology; pharmacy; outpatients; endoscopy; dental; radiology and Accident and Emergency departments. Together with a new kitchen, restaurant and offices.

The six roof top plantrooms provide all the heating, ventilation, air conditioning, hot and cold water services, medical gases and electrical services for the hospital.

The hospital services are controlled and monitored by a Building Management System.

This £25 million joint venture project was completed in just over two years. The Mechanical and Electrical services were worth approximately £10 million.
