The building serves two main functions, namely, Experimental via the Chemistry, Quality Control and Analytical Laboratories and also Administration and Support via the Directorate Areas, which include offices, library, seminar rooms, restaurant and kitchen.

The 16 Chemistry Laboratories are arranged on two main levels on both sides of a central longitudinal atrium with a further level above. This includes plant rooms incorporating the boilers and ventilation plant. Water chillers are also located at this level in screened compounds.

The £3.0 million Mechanical and Electrical Services contract was undertaken by Haden Young to meet the research, computing and comfort needs of the client's users.
