

New British Library, Completion Phase Euston, London

This phase included the fitting out of the main Reading Rooms and Book Storage Facilities and followed on from the earlier shell and core construction works.

The close working relationship between the Joint Venture partners was a major contribution to the successful execution of this complex major project which was delivered on programme and on budget.

The mechanical and electrical services element, which was worth in excess of £25 million, was completed in 1995.
